

Five Week Summer Intensive FAQs

When will I get the results of my auditions?

Audition results are emailed. Every attempt is made to send a response within two weeks of the audition date. If you haven't received results two weeks after your audition date, please email Kathy Wilson at kwilson@balletmet.org.

Will we get additional information about Summer Intensive?

There are additional forms that are emailed once we have received the student's registration form and deposits.

What time are classes during the Summer Intensive?

In general, classes Monday through Friday are 9:30am-5:00pm or 5:30pm. There are also classes on Saturdays from approximately 12:00pm-5:00pm.

How many students are in the classes?

Generally, there are 25-30 students in each level.

Do you offer Pas de Deux classes?

We offer Pas de Deux classes for students in the upper levels.

Is there a performance at the conclusion of the Summer Intensive?

We have two performances on the final Friday of the Summer Intensive. There is also the option to observe the ballet classes on the final day of Summer Intensive.

Where are out of town students housed?

Out of town students are housed at the Schottenstein Residence Hall at Columbus College of Art and Design.

What is included in the room and board?

Room and board includes all meals beginning with breakfast the first day of Summer Intensive and concluding with the final lunch on the Performance Day. Dinner on Move In day is available to be purchased at the dining hall.

How are dorm students transported to and from the BalletMet auditions?

Dorm students walk together with chaperones and CCAD security escorts to and from the residence hall and the studios. In the event of inclement weather, students are shuttled between locations.

Are there outings?

Yes, we have outings to area attractions as well as optional evening shuttles to Target and local grocery stores.

How many students to a room?

There are two students to a room and four students to a suite.

How old are the students in the dorms?

Dorm housing is available to students age 12 to 21.

May I bring my vehicle?

No, personal vehicles are not permitted at the BalletMet Summer Intensive.
